Ensure the Transportation industry has the requisite, skilled workforce to keep America's Mission people and goods moving. Transportation Workforce Institute (TWI), established in 2015 with seed funding from a **Overview** Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Innovative Public Transportation Workforce Development grant, is hosted by Los Angeles Trade-Technical College (LATTC), making it the first of its kind to be led by a community college in the US. LATTC has a 90-year history of providing workforce training and transfer opportunities and serves over 23,000 students annually from the greater Los Angeles region. TWI and the college are located at the epicenter of substantial transit activity, with over 40 rail and bus lines serving the region. TWI's purpose is to ensure a well-trained and diverse transportation workforce.
